

Book online at www.enrolmy.com/artkids. Payment is by direct debit and must be paid prior to class to confirm your booking.

NEW! Realistic Drawing 9 Yrs+ and now a follow-on Drawing Realistic class!

Many kids become frustrated and lose interest in drawing around 9-10 years of age as they move from imaginary and cartoon-style drawing to wanting to draw more realistically. They don't have the skills, get disheartened and give up. Our goal is keep kids drawing past this age and we are committed to running our Realistic Drawing sessions each school holiday. Over **three mornings** (Mon, Tues, Wed), we'll show your child how to make the move from cartoon to realistic drawing. We'll cover how to really 'see' an object, how to break it down into simple shapes and contour lines, how to create form through understanding shading and value, and how to position and draw objects in relation to one another.

<p>1: Realistic Drawing 9 Yrs+</p>  <p>Drawing is 80% observation and 20% drawing. Learn how to 'see' basic shapes and contour lines that make up everyday objects. We'll cover pencil grips and linework.</p>	<p>2: Realistic Drawing 9 Yrs+</p>  <p>Learn how to add texture and shading to create form. We'll cover light and dark, highlights and low lights, hatching techniques and value. Explore different drawing mediums - graphite, charcoal and chalk pastels.</p>	<p>3: Realistic Drawing 9 Yrs+</p>  <p>Learn how to use space to create the illusion of depth. Use overlap, size, shading, value, focus and perspective as you create and draw your own still life composition.</p>	<p>Chalk Pastel Glass Jar</p>  <p>Pull together your colour blending knowledge to create a chalk pastel still life. Make your stories visually appealing to your readers using close ups, pull outs and action words. Inspired by the book <i>Above and Below</i>, kids will learn about different ecosystems. They'll create their own 'above and below' artwork using painting, drawing and paper cutting techniques.</p>	<p>Along the Amazon Printmaking</p>  <p>Lots of techniques in this multi-step project! We focus on mono printing to create stilt houses and jungle foliage reflections in our Amazon River. Owl Family Fun</p>  <p>Draw a cute family of owls in this character portrait session. Every owl is complete with names, clothes, accessories and lots of style! Learn fun lettering techniques to draw and colour your name for your trinket box.
